

**Minutes from

1.     The changes in the bid opening for the Middle School roof project were reviewed. Bids will now be opened on Wednesday, April 20, 2005 at 2:00 P.M.
2.     The other Life/Safety projects were reviewed. Bleacher selection will be recommended to the entire School Board; selling the “old” H.S. gym floor will take place at the end of the school year; and the “old” track will be removed in early June.
3.     The walkway between the H.S. and the facility was discussed. The District is still waiting for plan changes and approval from FGM.
4.     Mr. Schlindwein distributed information about natural gas bidding. The first presentation will be on April 13, 2005.
5.     At the April 12, 2005 School Board Meeting, Mr. Schlindwein will be recommending that Great Western Supply Co. be our janitorial supply company.
6.     A brief list of summer maintenance projects was distributed. A complete list will be distributed to all Board members at the May meeting.
7.     The Committee recommended that the H.S. Building Trades Class investigate other projects for 2005-06 (other than building a house).
8.     After July 1, 2005, the maintenance department will work on replacing the existing sign in front of the H.S., so it says “Geneseo High School.”
9.     Mr. Schlindwein distributed to the Committee ideas from the H.S. Physical Education Dept. and Mr. Payne regarding locker rooms and office spaces. The Committee will review the handouts and try to tour the building in April.

At 8:00 P.M., the Committee moved to the SW gym for the rest of the meeting.
