PSAE Incentives/Rewards for Seniors of 2016

Level I

- Exceed in two or more categories of PSAE (Day 2) $\sim \mathbf{OR} \sim$
- Hit all four ACT benchmarks (Day 1)
 - 1. Exempt from semester 1 and 2 exams in areas <u>exceeded and met</u>, including one related course* if the student does not have a core course (Reading, Math or Science) in that category.¹
 - 2. Choice of parking spot and free parking tag (\$5.00 deposit still applies).
 - 3. Open Campus Lunch privilege once a month starting in September (dates to be determined by the administration)
 - 4. Second semester study hall iPod/MP3 privilege: Use of iPod/MP3 in SH if SH is in the middle of the student schedule. Eligibility is tied to discipline record, attendance record, fines or fees past due.
 - 5. Hallway locker choice.
 - 6. Ten cookies from the lunchroom.

Level II

- Exceed in one area of PSAE (Day 2) and meet in all other areas of exam $\sim \mathbf{OR} \sim$
- Hit three out of four ACT benchmarks (Day 1)
 - 1. Exempt from semester 1 exams in area exceeded on PSAE exam.¹
 - 2. Exempt from semester 2 exams in area <u>exceeded and met</u> on the PSAE, including a related course* if student does not have a core course (Reading, Math or Science) in that category.¹
 - 3. Choice of parking spot and 50% off parking tag price (\$5.00 deposit applies).
 - 4. Open Campus Lunch privilege once a month starting in December (dates to be determined by the administration)
 - 5. Second semester study hall iPod/MP3 privilege at mid-point of 3rd quarter:
 - 6. Five cookies from the lunchroom.

Level III

- Meet in all areas of PSAE (Day 2) $\sim \mathbf{OR} \sim$
- Hit two out of four ACT benchmarks (Day 1)
 - 1. Exempt from semester 2 exams in areas <u>met</u> on the PSAE, including a related course* if student does not have a core course (Reading, Math or Science) in that category.¹
 - 2. Choice parking spot and 25% off parking tag price (\$5.00 deposit applies).
 - 3. Open Campus Lunch privilege once a month starting in March (dates to be determined by the administration)
 - 4. Fourth quarter study hall iPod/MP3 privilege: Use of iPod/MP3 in SH if SH is in the middle of the student schedule. Eligibility is tied to discipline record, attendance record, fines or fees past due.

ACT Jump: Seniors who qualify for Level II or Level III privileges will be eligible to move up one level if they exceed their projected ACT score that was determined based upon their PLAN test scores.

¹If you are failing a class for which you have a PSAE exam exemption, this exemption is revoked.
