COURSE DESCRIPTION: This class will focus on basic fundamentals and terminology of web design. We will explore different internet related careers as well as learn how web design relates to the overall operation of a business in today's computer based world. Once basic web design procedures are learned, students will complete some activities using designing software.

COURSE LEARNING OBJECTIVES: Students will be able to:

- Identify concepts of web page design
- Prepare a simple webpage
- Define the differences between HTML and CSS
- Analyze the advantages and disadvantages of Dreamweaver
- Analyze the advantages and disadvantages of Photoshop
- Students will relate webpage design by completing a computer design simulation that challenges them to create a website.
