RE: WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Geneseo CUSD #228 is currently developing an effective Water Quality Management Plan that is essential in ensuring that safe, potable drinking water is maintained at all times in all pre-k-5 school buildings.

The Geneseo schools has selected a team of custodians and maintenance personnel to perform the Mitigation Strategies outlined below.

Mitigation Plan:

1. Provide education of lead in drinking water to staff.
2. Take out aerators on fixtures to increase flow.
3. The first day returning after a weekend the daytime custodian will flush the mainline selected to be flushed for 15 minutes. (This will be done weekly)
4. At winter & summer breaks longer than a week, the district maintenance staff will perform a preventative maintenance task of cleaning filters, strainers and replacing if needed.
5. Re-test drinking fountains & kitchen fixtures every 5 years in all pre-k-5 buildings.
