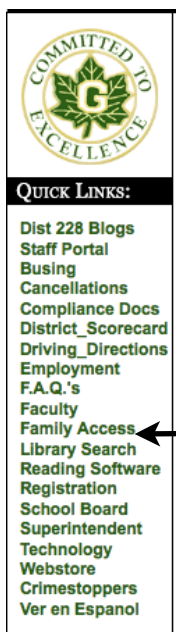


# Test Scores ~ Skyward ~ Family Access



Dear 2nd Grade Parents,

Your child's assessment scores are entered into the Skyward (family access) website several times per year. You can access the website by going to ***geneseoschools.org*** and clicking on the words "Family Access" on the left side of the screen. You will need to use your password to enter the system. Please contact your school secretary if you have forgotten your password. Once you have accessed your child's page, click on test scores on the left side. You will see your child's scores in areas of Math, Writing, and DRA2 (reading).

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## Explanation of Test Scores

### **DRA2 = (Developmental Reading Assessment):**

Your child will be evaluated in reading several times during the year. One of the assessment tools that will be used is the DRA2. The goal in second grade is to have each student reading at a level 28 F (fiction) by the end of the school year. When you click on the DRA2 section you will first see the date the assessment was given. You will also see the test level, which is the highest level that your child passed. Finally, you will see the performance level (PERF) with the letters B and O.

**B**=performing below grade level: **O**=performing on grade level.

**MATH:** The local math assessment is given in the fall, mid-year, and spring with the purpose of showing growth and mastery of the 2nd grade math curriculum. The assessment has a total of 24 questions. The score listed is the total number of problems that your child got correct.

**WRITING:** For our local writing assessment your child will be writing a response to a specific prompt in the fall and the spring. For comparison purposes, the prompt will be similar for both assessments. Their writing will be assessed in two areas: **Ideas** and **Organization**. There are 6 points possible in each area. In the fall average scores are in the 2 - 3 range. Most second graders score in the 4 - 5 range in the spring.
