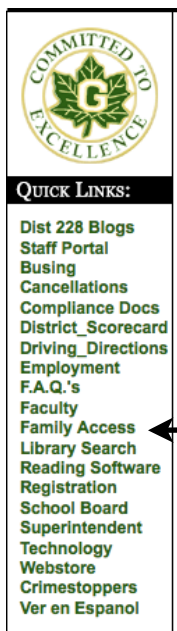


Test Scores ~ Skyward ~ Family Access

Dear 4th Grade Parents,



Your child's assessment scores have been entered into the Skyward (family access) website. You can access the website by going to geneseoschools.org and clicking on the words "Family Access" on the left side of the screen. You will need to know your password to get into the system. If you don't remember it, you can contact your school secretary for it. Once you have accessed your child's page, click on test scores on the left side.

In order for the scores to make sense to you, there are a few explanations below.

DRA2= Developmental Reading Assessment: We will assess your child many times during the school year in the area of reading. Our goal is to have your child reach level 40 NF by the end of their 4th grade school year. When you click on test scores on your child's page, you will see many different entries for the DRA. For example, if you click on DRA2 Spring score, you will see the score they received. You will also see boxes with the DATE the assessment was given, the LEVEL (34,38, etc.) and PERF (performance) with the letters B and O. The B=performing below grade level: O=performing on grade level.

MATH: The maximum points possible on the math assessment is 36 points. This assessment will be given in the fall, mid-year, and spring with the purpose of showing growth and mastery of the 4th grade math curriculum.

WRITING: Your child will be writing a response to a specific prompt in the fall and the spring. For comparison purposes, the prompt will be the same for both assessments. This writing will be assessed in two areas: Ideas/Content and Organization. Ideas/Content = 9 possible points : Organization = 12 possible points.
