

# WELCOME to KINDERGARTEN

Registration for children planning to attend Kindergarten in Geneseo Community Unit School District #228 for the 2018-19 school year will be held:

**Thursday, April 19, 2018 – Millikin Elem. School 2:00-7:00 PM**

### **Requirements to attend Kindergarten for 2018-19:**

Child must turn 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2018

### **What should I bring to Kindergarten Registration**

1. Certified copy of child’s birth certificate
2. One Category 1 proof of residency document
3. Two Category 2 proof of residency documents

<b>Category 1</b>	<b>Category 2</b>
Most recent property tax bill and proof of payment	Driver’s License
Mortgage papers	Vehicle Registration
Signed and dated lease and proof of last month’s payment	Voter Registration
Letter of residence from landlord in lieu of lease	Most recent cable television and/or credit card bill
Letter from park manager and proof of last month’s payment (trailer park residents)	Current public aid card
Letter of residence to be used when the person seeking to enroll a student is living with a District resident	Current homeowners/renters’ insurance policy and premium payment receipt
Most recent property tax bill and proof of payment	Most recent gas, electric, and/or water bill
	Current library card
	Receipt for moving van rental
	Mail received at new residence

### **Registration Packet (to be turned in at registration):**

1. Packets will be available for completion at registration.
2. Registration packets may be found at: [geneseoschools.org](http://geneseoschools.org) under “Kindergarten Registration Information 2018-19”. Forms can be printed at home and brought with you to registration on April 19<sup>th</sup>. The “parent information” link provides further information for registering your Kindergarten student.

**Additional Information:**

- All incoming Kindergarten students will need to provide Proof of Residency. Please note even if you have older children in the Geneseo School District, you will be required to provide this information as well.
- Parents/Guardians must present the new student's **certified or registered birth certificate**. Hospital certificates are not acceptable.
- Prior to the first day of kindergarten, a completed health examination form and immunization record must be submitted to the school nurse.
- Parents/guardians of students entering kindergarten must present a completed dental exam form showing proof of having been examined by a licensed dentist.
- Parents/guardians of students entering kindergarten must present a completed vision exam form showing proof of having had an eye examination.

The District website is a valuable reference. Be sure to visit it often for information regarding back to school and more!

**Registration fees will be collected online in July 2018. If this is the first student in your family to attend Geneseo schools, information will be mailed regarding the online payment procedure. If necessary, payment may be made in person at the District Office after July 6.**
