### Immunizations will be given to:

#### ★ 11-18 yr. olds

~ Meningococcal (Protects children from Meningitis.) An infection of the fluid surrounding the brain & spinal cord. Many need this for college entry.

~ Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, & pertussis) Needed for High School entry, and to protect your family and others from whooping cough. If your child did not receive a pertussis component vaccine when entering High School they may receive it.

~ Varicella (Chicken Pox) 2 doses are recommended if they did not have the disease.

#### ★ H1N1

~ will be available for all ages and especially for those who were 9 yrs and under and did not receive the recommended booster (2nd dose) for optimal response.

#### ★ Tdap for Adults 19 thru 64 yrs. of age

~ who are close contacts/caregivers of infants less than 1 yr. of age on the WIC program (recommended to protect infants particularly against pertussis).

**Parental Consent is needed for those under 18 years of age.**  
**Please bring Immunization Records to the clinic!**
